How to reach Tours

- From Charles de Gaulle-Roissy Airport take either the train to Tours at the "Gare TGV" (high speed train) contiguous to Airport 2 C-D or take the Air France bus or a taxi to Paris-Gare Montparnasse, Montparnasse train station (highest frequency of trains to Tours).
- From Orly Airport take the Air France bus or a taxi to Paris-Gare Montparnasse, Montparnasse Station and the train to Tours at Gare Montparnasse.
- Tickets: SNCF (railway) reduced-price tickets can be obtained from the Secretariat of the Symposium.
- Schedules: look at the SNCF website: http://www.voyages-sncf.com
- Tours can easily be reached by high speed train (TGV) from different european cities.

Examples: from Lyon, 2 trains per day at a 3-hour trip duration – from Lille, 4 trains per day, at a 2.30-hour trip duration – from Bordeaux, 8 trains per day at à 2.20-hour trip duration – London, 3 trains per day at a 5.15-hour trip duration – Brussels, 1 train per day at a 3.30-hour trip duration.

• By car, Tours is situated on the Loire River at 233 km South/West from Paris, 110 Km West from Orléans and 330 km North from Bordeaux. It takes about 2 hours to come to Tours from Paris by the A10 Aquitaine Highway. In the South of Paris at Porte d'Orléans or Porte d'Italie, take the highway 6A or 6B direction "Lyon" and afterward when indicated, follow direction "Bordeaux" to reach Tours, exit 21: "Tours Centre".
